Connie Handyside made motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Booth for the City Clerk to check with our insurance on this as well as for Doug Smeltser to jet this main out every month. Vote was Connie Handyside aye, Joe Booth aye, Sherry Bunker aye.

George Hausdorf was next on Bacteria regiment for the sludge control at the lagoon. He stated that last fall the City had purchased 3 totes of Bugs which had been slowly introduced into the lagoon, he went on to state that we would need 3 more Totes this spring to be done the same way. George has checked and the cost is \$5000.00 a tote. Joe Booth made motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sherry Bunker to order the 3 totes. Vote was Joe Booth aye, Sherry Bunker aye, Connie Handyside aye.

George has ordered a “DR 4400” for the City a new meter for testing of dissolved oxygen and also 2 new probes. The City has to have this for their testing, the old tester has quit working. Cost of this will be between 2 and 3 thousand dollars.

Doug Smeltser was asked if he had anything to report and he said he did not. Tim Vice was asked if he had anything to report, and he did not.

Connie Handyside made motion second by Sherry Bunker to adjourn. Vote was Connie Handyside aye, Sherry Bunker aye, Joe Booth aye.
